

## INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL GUIDELINES:

All international travel requires you to follow the [Massachusetts Travel Advisory](#).

In our effort to keep our school communities as low risk as possible, the Public Schools of Northborough and Southborough require these guidelines be met when returning to school after international travel.

INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL	THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA MUST BE MET TO RETURN TO SCHOOL
<p>If your international travel includes any of the following higher risk situations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Travel by plane, bus, train</b></li><li>● <b>Travel by car with individuals from outside your household.</b></li><li>● <b>Travel to amusement parks or other densely populated venues.</b></li><li>● <b>Travel that includes unmasked activities with people from outside of your household</b></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Quarantine for 7 days upon arrival to MA with proof of student*/staff negative <b>PCR test</b> on or after Day 5 (Day 0 is date of arrival in MA)</li><li>● Return to school on Day 8 after return to MA</li><li>● If no test, quarantine for 10 days, return to school on Day 11</li></ul>

\*all students regardless of age

### PLEASE NOTE:

- These requirements must be met even if you are fully vaccinated or have tested positive within the last 90 days.
- No vaccine is 100% effective, protective measures should still be taken seriously even after you are fully vaccinated.
