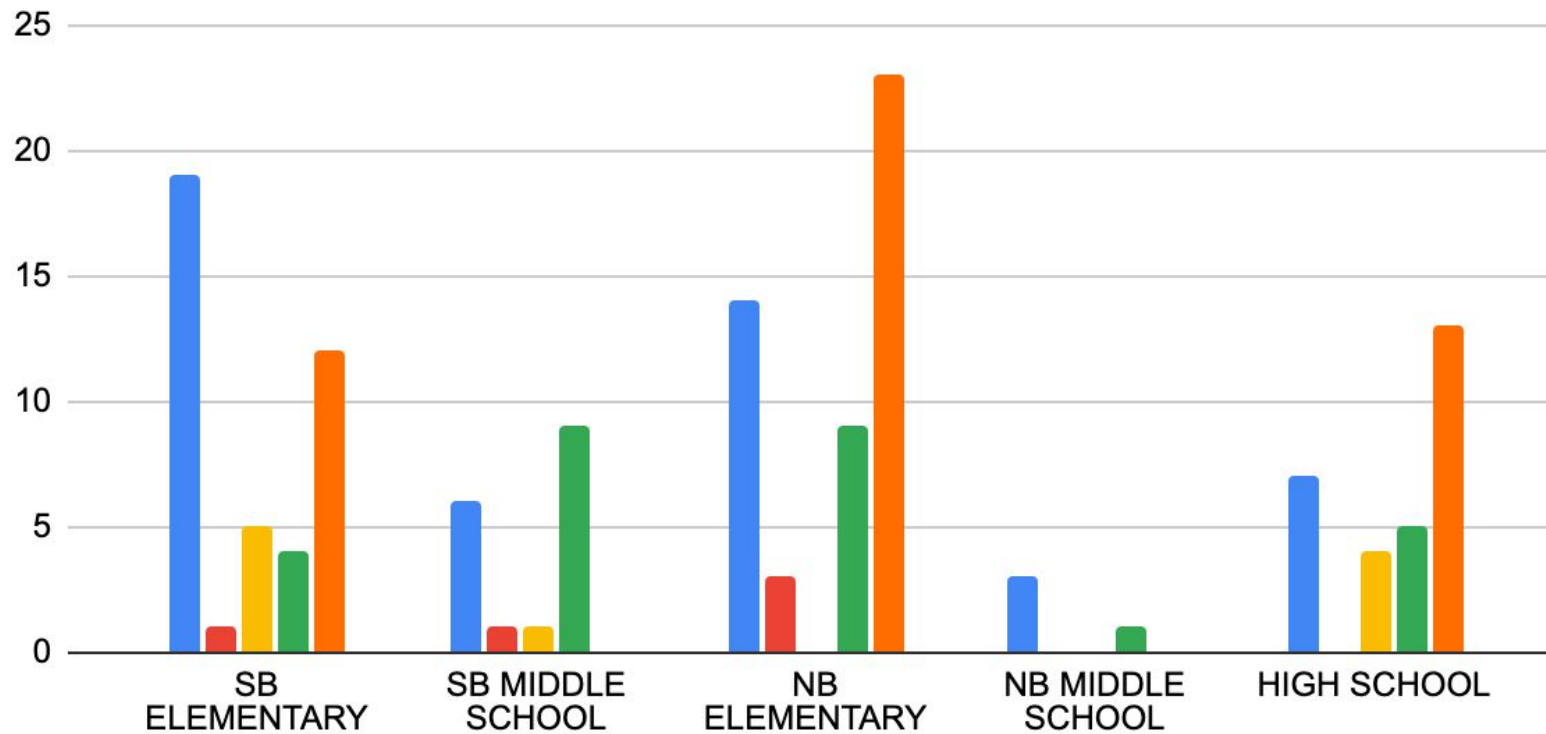

## DEFINITIONS:

**Isolation:** In consultation with public health officials, keeping someone, with or without symptoms, who tested positive for COVID-19 away from others.

**Quarantine:** In consultation with public health officials, restricting movement or separating healthy individuals who may have been exposed to the virus from the rest of the population to monitor symptoms and detect cases early.
