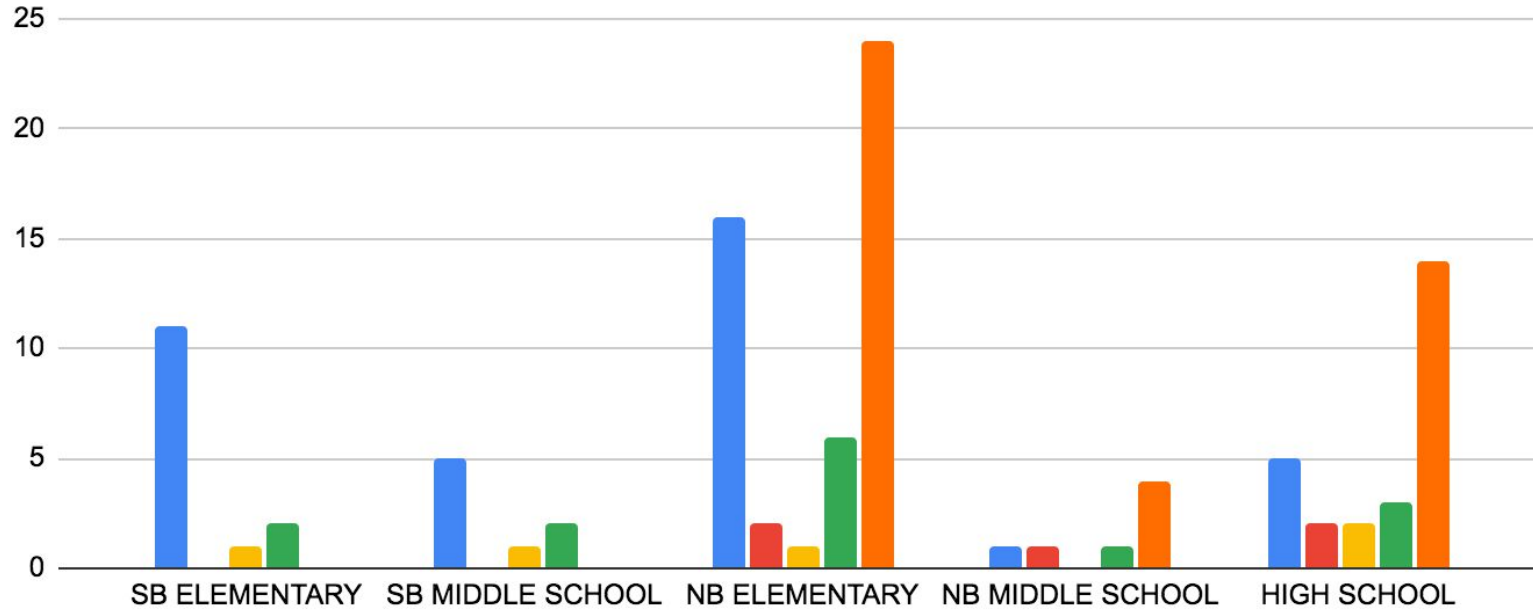

DEFINITIONS:

Isolation: In consultation with public health officials, keeping someone, with or without symptoms, who tested positive for COVID-19 away from others. Isolation typically lasts 10 days from the onset of symptoms or if asymptomatic, from the date of the positive test. Normal activities can resume on day 11 after positive test.

Quarantine: In consultation with public health officials, restricting movement or separating healthy individuals who may have been exposed to the virus from the rest of the population to monitor symptoms and detect cases early. These individuals are identified through contact tracing, symptoms or travel. Quarantine typically last for 14 days, from the last date of contact with the COVID positive individual. Normal activities can resume on day 15 after exposure.
