

## TRAVEL QUARANTINE:

All travel outside of Massachusetts requires you to follow the [Massachusetts Travel Order](#). In addition to this the Northborough/Southborough Public Schools require the following criteria be met to return to school after travel outside of Massachusetts.

TRAVEL	STATE CRITERIA	RETURN TO SCHOOL CRITERIA
Travel to New England states (NH, VT, ME, RI, CT) or New York	Follow <a href="#">MA Travel Order</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Proof of student*/staff negative <b>PCR test</b> up to 72 hours prior to arrival in MA</li> <li>• If no test, quarantine for 10 days</li> <li>• Check in with school nurse upon return to school</li> </ul>
Travel outside of <a href="#">lower risk states</a> (except New England or New York)	Follow <a href="#">MA Travel Order</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Quarantine for 7 days upon arrival to MA with proof of student*/staff negative <b>PCR test</b> on or after Day 5 (Day 0 is date of arrival in MA)</li> <li>• Return to school on Day 8 after return to MA</li> <li>• If no test, quarantine for 10 days</li> <li>• Check in with school nurse upon return to school</li> </ul>

\*all students regardless of age

### PLEASE NOTE:

- For short term travel out of MA (<72 hours), the PCR test must be performed after you leave the state and prior to or after your return. You must quarantine until you have the negative test result.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 90 days, you do NOT need to test and you do NOT need to quarantine.
