Dear Parent(s) and Guardian(s):

I begin this week's update by acknowledging the great thought and care families placed in making the decision between the Hybrid Model or the Stand Alone Remote Program (SARP). I know that for many families that this was not an easy decision to make and the reasons behind each family's decision varied due to a family's context. With that said, and with the deadline for enrolling in the SARP passed, the District now has SARP enrollment numbers. These data allow the District to identify the SARP staffing needs and begin the detailed work that remains.

This week, the District made significant progress in developing cohorts that keep siblings in the same one. The process began at the high school level, moved to the middle school level, and ended with the cohorts being finalized at the elementary levels. Later next week, school principals will communicate cohort assignments to families.
