As of today October 13, 2020, we have received a total of **ten student's applications** for this pilot program. **In order for us to open we would need a total of 20 students!**

The basic information of Remote Learning Center (RLC) K-5

- Cohort "A" attending school Wednesday and Friday – NEDP will call this group "A" attending RLC Tuesday & Thursday
- Cohort "B" attending school Tuesday and Thursday – NEDP will call this group "B" attending RLC Wednesday & Friday
- The RLC will be located at The Church of Nativity, 45 Howard St., Northborough, MA
- Hours: 8:00am – 3pm (Closed on Mondays)
- Students will be in groups of 10, with the same students and the same two educators each time they attend the RLC.
- Families provide their child with two snacks and a lunch that does not require heating.
- Students will bring their own personal devices for online learning, headphones and charging equipment
- Families may register for one Group "A" or "B"
- Cost is \$620 per month per child – there are no discounts on siblings
- No drop-in option

What will a typical day at RLC look like?

Students will arrive with their parent/guardian where an NEDP educator will check him/her into the RLC. Parents will conduct a COVID-19 screening with their child prior to dropping off. The educators will plan each child's day around when they need to be logged in/out and will help them with their technology and access to the greatest extent possible. Because each child's schedule will be different, there will be a transition period at the start of the program to figure out the plan for the day. In addition to the learning times, educators will build in mask break times, arts & crafts, games and free play, snack and lunch time. There will be opportunities for the students to go outside as much as possible, especially during the good weather!

COVID-19 Safety Plan

The Department of Education and Care (EEC) has stringent protocols in place for cleaning and disinfecting the program space to which we adhere to. In addition, we will follow the district's safe and healthy protocols which includes requiring all students and educators wear masks, wash hands frequently and social distance 6 feet apart. Each student and educator will participate in the screening process prior to entering the program site. There will be a designated isolation space for students who may become ill while at the RLC. There will be a process in case of exposure to COVID-19.
