

ANNUAL NOTICE REGARDING WEBSITE ACCESSIBILITY

Each year, the Public Schools of Northborough and Southborough conduct a district-wide website accessibility review. This accessibility review includes assessing each of the websites, including all schools and District pages, to ensure that the information contained on each website, and all pages located within each site, comply with the requirements of Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act, which also satisfies the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Each school and District is responsible for ensuring compliance with Section 508. Each school district is required to designate an individual no later than August 1 to conduct the annual website review and then to oversee corrections. Julie Doyle, Director of Instructional Technology and Digital Learning is responsible for conducting the assessment of the district level pages and for compiling the reports from all the schools. The method used will be a testing engine (AMP) and a manual review of the reports, and the standards used will be the standards established by Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act.

The District designates Julie Doyle, Director of Instructional Technology and Digital Learning to review all of the annual reports and to monitor steps to correct any problems. The final review and report is due to the Superintendent of Schools no later than September 15 each year.
