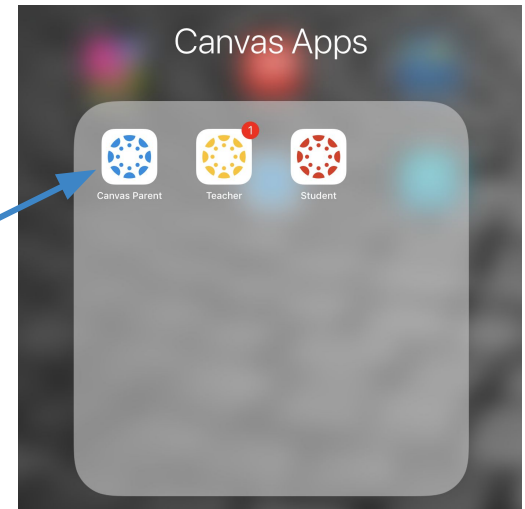

Canvas Parent App: Logging in

Please complete these steps to begin using the [Canvas Parent App](#) on your smartphone or tablet.

Step 1: Download the free [Canvas Parent App](#). Make sure you download the **Parent App** as there is also a Student App and a Teacher App.

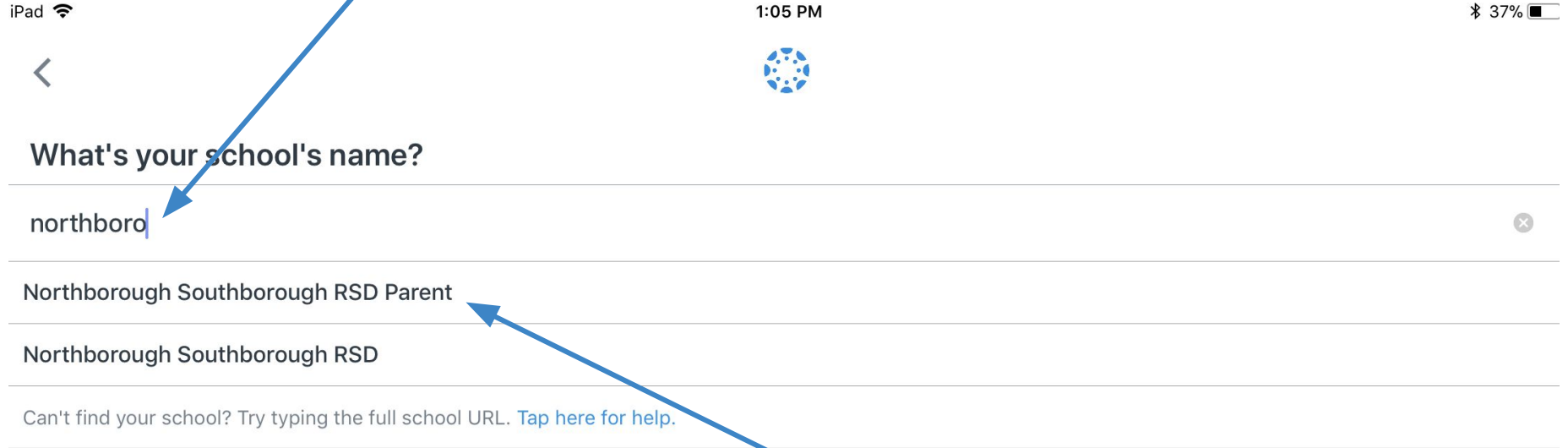
Step 2: Open the app and then begin the login process by clicking on the blue **Find my school** button.

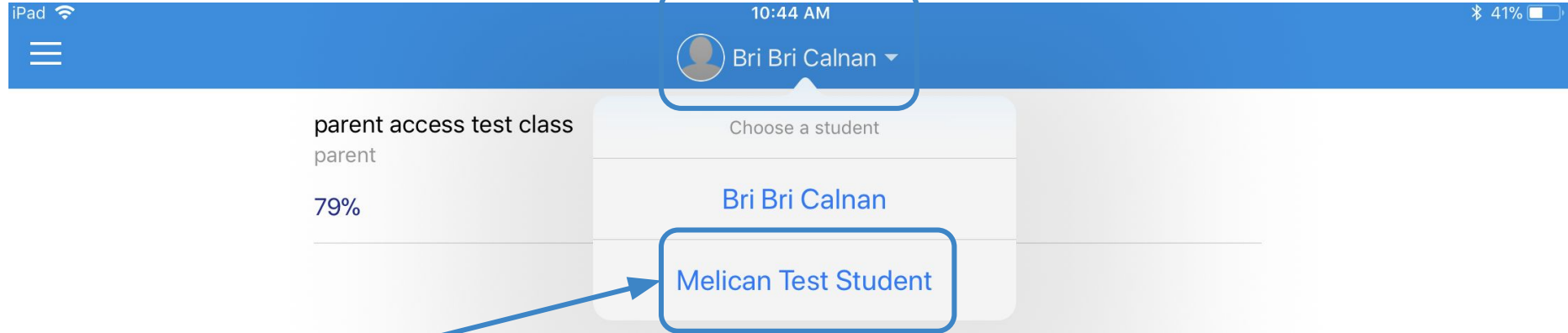
Step 4B: Click the blue **Log In** button

If you have multiple children (at MMS or ARHS) you will be able to switch between the two by...

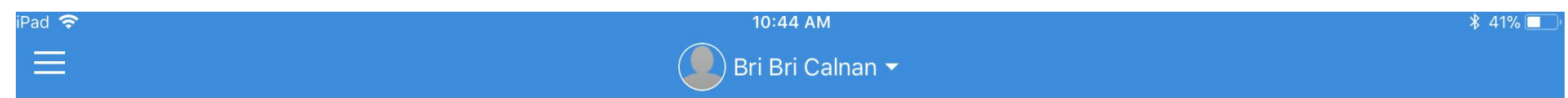
Step 1: Click on the student name found in the middle of the banner at the top of the screen.

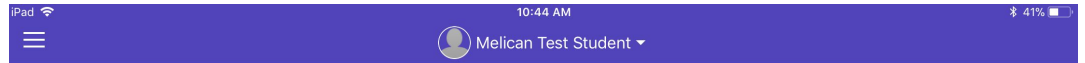

Canvas Parent App: Viewing Grades

To the right, is my view of my “Melican Test Student.” There are three icons at the bottom of the screen. Here is what each means for you:

Alerts: If you set up notifications (info found on next slide) that information will appear here.

Week: See what assignments are due or coming up for the week. Please note that this option is tied to your calendar in the web version. You must turn on the course calendars you wish to see here on the web version calendar first.

Courses: View your child’s grades. If you click on a class in this list, it will direct you to the week’s assignments just for that class.

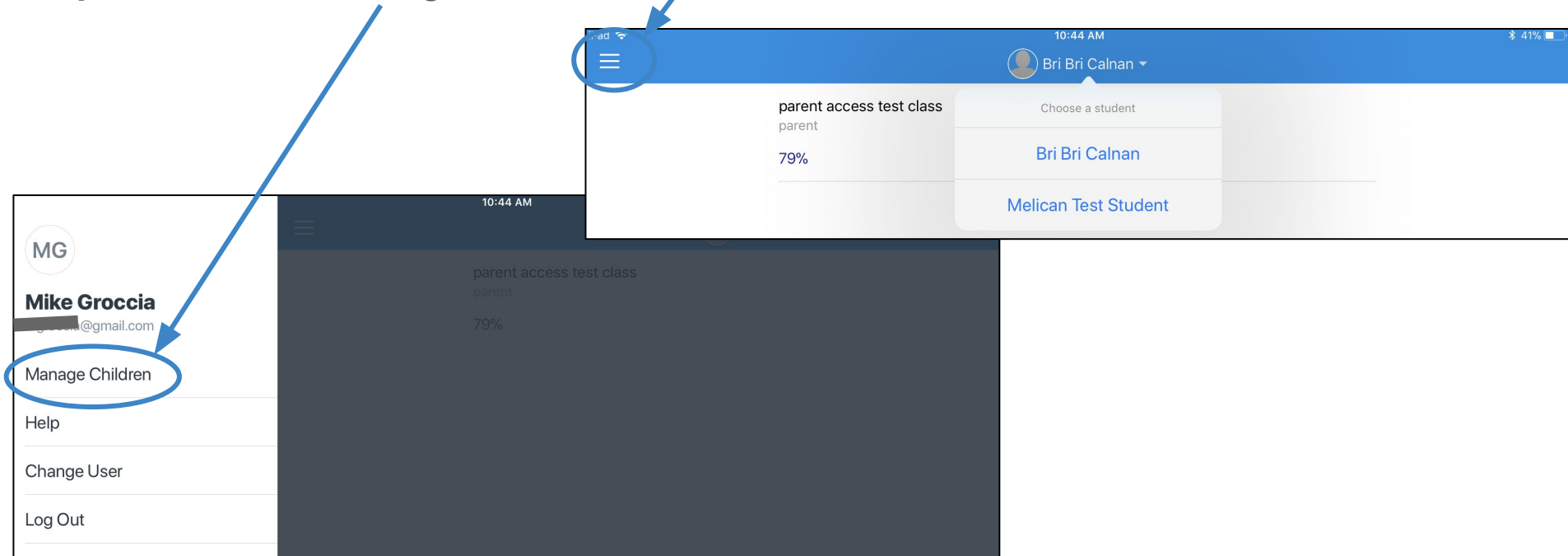

Using the Canvas Parent app, there are some options available to help you customize the type of information you would like to see on the app.

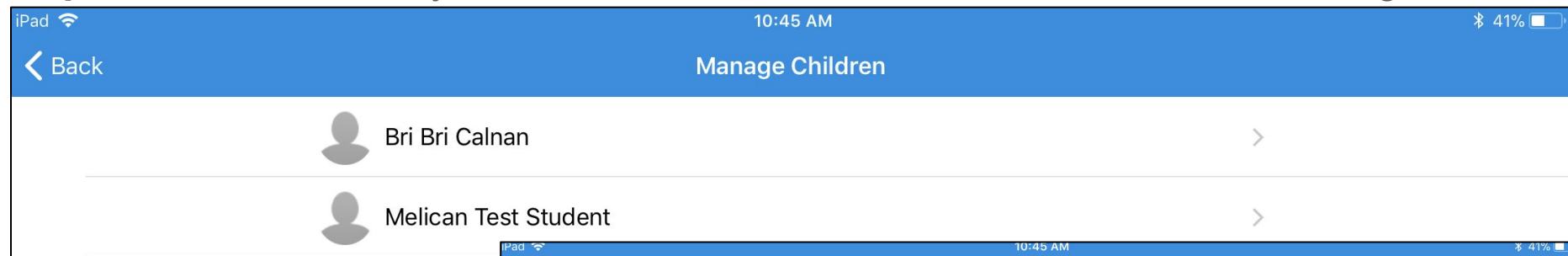
Step 1: Click on the 3 horizontal lines located in the upper left hand corner.

Step 2: Click on “Manage Children”
